

## **GOLD LICENCE: INFORMATION FOR 2010**

### **What is a Gold Licence?**

The Gold Licence is for people who wish to spend time cruising on a combination of British Waterways and Environment Agency navigations. EA navigations include the River Thames, Anglian waterways and River Medway: currently each of these areas has its own registration/licensing scheme.

The Gold Licence replaces the need for separate licences from the different authorities and covers all BW and EA navigations (including Scotland).

It is a twelve month licence and registration for powered craft only. It doesn't cover the tender to a boat – you need to register or license this separately with the individual authorities.

### **What does it cost?**

If your boat is less than 3.5 metres (11'5") wide, the cost is upward from £440 depending on its length. The fee sheet for boats under 3.5m wide is printed on page 4.

You can obtain a formal quotation for a wider boat by calling 0845 671 5530 (Mon-Fri 8am – 6pm, 9 - 1pm Saturdays).

A Gold licence can be more economical than separate licences from the different navigation authorities, depending on the length of time you intend to spend away from your home navigation on any of the waterways covered by the licence.

### **When is it available?**

All Gold licences run from January 1<sup>st</sup> – 31 December 2010 irrespective of when you apply.

### **How can I get a refund on my current, unexpired licence or registration?**

Your home navigation may issue a pro rata refund for full months unused, providing you send your old, unexpired licence disks back to the original issuing office with your refund request.

However, if you are paying by Direct Debit please contact British Waterways Customer Services Centre, for confirmation of the refund procedure.

### **A Gold Licence is non refundable.**

### **Discounts**

- Vessels which are powered solely by electricity: 25% discount.
- BW prompt payment discount is already deducted from the payment in full. (See page 4)
- Historic boats on BW waterways claiming the 10% discount should contact Customer Services Centre who will calculate the value of your discount on your Gold Licence for you – it is a complicated formula as the 10% can only be applied to the BW element of your Gold Licence.

## Payment methods

- cheque, cash or postal order. Cheques payable to British Waterways.  
Only send cash by registered post.
- Visa, Mastercard or Switch/Maestro
- Direct Debit
  - ⇒ in one single payment
  - ⇒ over 5 months (see fee list)
  - ⇒ over 9 months (see fee list)

If you pay in nine instalments, the first payment is 20% of the total amount due and is collected on the licence start date. The remaining instalments are equal amounts collected on the first day of the following months. The prompt payment discount is not available for instalment payments, but is already included in the payment in full. (see page 4)

## What requirements are there?

- A valid Boat Safety Scheme Certificate OR Declaration of Conformity with the Recreational Craft Directive. The latter must include the boat specifications and your declaration. If your boat is an open vessel powered solely by an outboard engine and it has no appliances for cooking, heating, refrigeration or lighting, it will probably be exempt from this requirement – ask us for an exemption form and enclose it with your Gold Licence application.
- Proof that you have third party liability insurance cover in place for a minimum of £1 million.
- Once you have obtained your Gold Licence, you must display the discs prominently on both sides of your vessel. Registration documents issued by relevant navigation authorities must be carried aboard your vessel. (Please remove all old discs.)

## Where can I use the Gold Licence?

A full list of waterways is printed overleaf (see page 3).

## How long does it take to issue a licence?

Please allow 15 working days from receipt of your completed application.

## Access keys

A single key fits all BW sanitary facilities, locks & swing bridges (£6.00), and a handcuff key (£5.00) is also required to open some of the locks on British Waterways navigations. They are available from British Waterways Customer Services Centre, waterway offices, chandlers and on-line at [www.waterscape.com/shop](http://www.waterscape.com/shop)

A separate waterway key is required for the River Nene (£5.00) per key, available from the Environment Agency at the Peterborough office T 01733 464 909.

## Safe and responsible boating

You must familiarise yourself with and follow the regulations set by each navigation authority. For a copy of the Boaters' Handbook, contact BW Customer Services Centre or any BW or EA office.

## Temporary restrictions

Please check [www.waterscape.com/stoppages](http://www.waterscape.com/stoppages) for stoppage information before travel. British Waterways' main repair programme runs from October to April. To receive a copy each year please tick the box on the bottom of the application form.
